MAURICE CHARRIÈRE has danced and taught in the Bay Area for over 20 years, including Berkeley City Ballet and Shawl-Anderson. He has performed many duets with his wife, Reenie, and was a member of the RPMs, Jade Dance, Sara McLennan and Rebecca Saltzer Dance Theater and more. His exposure to European Dance Theater (Pina Bausch, Maguy Marin among others) has made him a natural fan of that form and infuses his teachings with its energy. Adept at both Classical and Modern styles he designs his classes as a laboratory for both technique and improvisation, on the principle that there's only one lesson: to learn how to learn. He is also the drama teacher at Ecole Bilingue in Berkeley.

TROY MACKLIN began dancing at San Ramon Valley Dance Academy at the age of 5. He is a 2008 alumnus of The Juilliard School where he received his BFA in Dance. He has taught arts literacy courses for children and began a summer arts outreach program to spread arts education across the Bay Area. He was a principal dancer, rehearsal director, and teacher with Rebecca Davis Dance Company in Philadelphia in 2008. In 2009 Troy freelanced in Philadelphia and NYC with Breath Dance Project, Kazuko Hirabayashi Dance Theater, 360 Degree Dance Company and others. Troy has traveled across the world teaching dance, spreading arts education, and showcasing his choreography at venues from New York to Texas to California.
